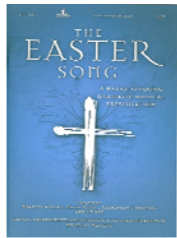

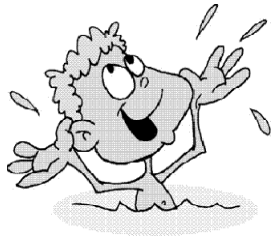
celebrate this special theme on Sunday night, May 31 in conjunction with our
