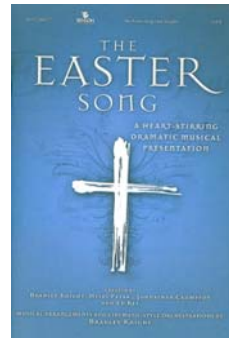

We currently have 16 surveillance cameras throughout the facility to increase the safety of our children and adults and also to digitally store and record all activity throughout our facility 24/7. We have already had 10 minor incident reports stored and recorded since the inception of our security back in December. Our security team continues to do a yeoman's labor as they seek to keep every aspect of our people safe. Keep in mind that cameras can't bring ultimate peace to our hearts; only obedience to Christ can bring that abiding peace; however we seek to be wise stewards of the peoples and facilities that we are entrusted with here on this earth.
